THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

StarLasers offers the Starlight Series One (Argon only), the Starlight Series One-FC (Full Color/Argon and Krypton), the Starlight Series One-WL (Full Color/White Light), and the Starlight Series One-UV (Ultraviolet) projection systems plus a full range of remote fiberoptic modules. These systems utilize high or low power argon, krypton, white light, or UV lasers, as well as HeNe lasers for small indoor use. The use of large frame lasers allows bright, highly visible shows indoors or outdoors. The Starlight Series projection systems are built for maximum endurance--the system installed at Universal Studios Tours Battlestar Galactica performed up to 230 shows per day, 7 days a week for more than 6 years.

The large frame lasers are water cooled (3.5 to 5 gallons per minute) and use 480 volt 3 phase power at 60-75 amps per phase. Smaller water cooled or air cooled lasers may also be used. Systems are available for rental, lease, or purchase. Prices will be quoted on an individual basis. We welcome the opportunity to work with you on your next project. 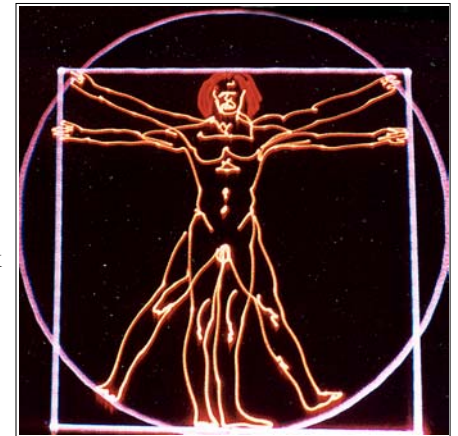

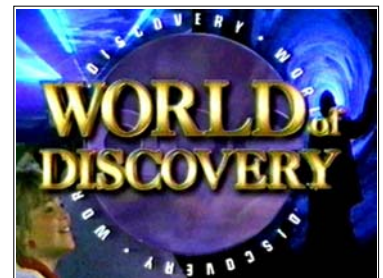

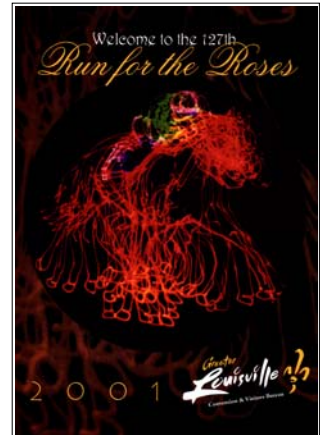
